RED DUCHESS

Very hardy, medium to large size red apple. Fruit is tart & juicy. Good for eating, but best for pies & sauces. Abundant fruit, annual bearer. Short storage life.

HONEYCRISP

Exceptionally crisp & juicy. Flavor is sweet but well-balanced. Excellent storage life, up to 7 months. Has become an outstanding commercial & home orchard variety because of its explosive crispness, flavor.

FROSTBITE

Small apple with a very sweet, intense taste. Crisp but firm texture & juicy. Extremely cold hardy, it is an excellent variety for cold, northern regions. Great for cider or cooking.

WINECRISP

Cream-colored flesh is juicy with full spicy flavors. This apple has shown excellent resistance to scab. Late ripening variety prolongs the harvest season. Use for fresh eating & cooking. Very good storage life.

SNOWSWEET

Has a deliciously sweet, slightly tart taste. Slow to oxidize when exposed to air. 'Honeycrisp' is a good pollinator. Above average resistance to scab & fireblight.



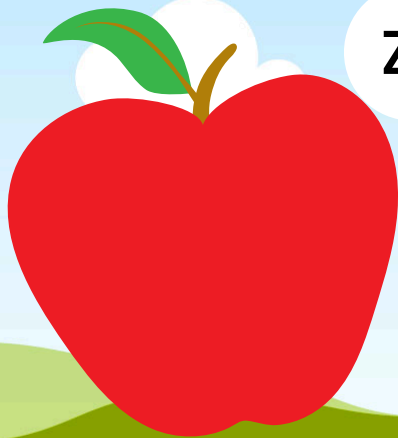

WEALTHY

Striped red fruit with a tart balanced flavor. Multi-purpose apple but especially good for cooking. Often bears fruit the first year. Keeps well. Fruit tends to drop at maturity.

MCINTOSH

A well-known older apple that has a sprightly flavor & a medium storage life. Heavy bearer. Good for eating & baking. Fruit tends to drop when ripe.

WOLF RIVER

An old variety, hardy & long lived. Best known for its large size - up to 5" diameter fruit. Primarily used as a cooking apple.

ZESTAR

Excellent sweet tart flavor. Has a much longer storage life than other early apples. Excellent for fresh eating & cooking.

WHITNEY CRABAPPLE

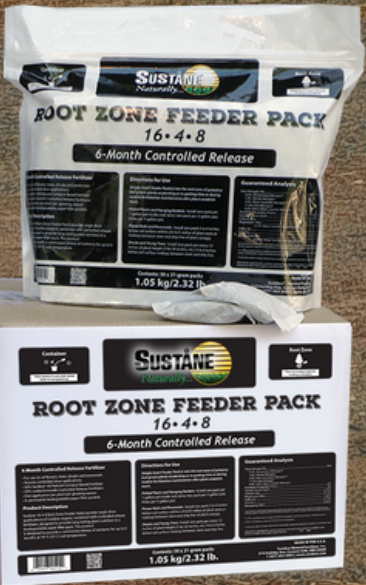
Fruit is yellow with red stripes. Good for eating & pickling. Hardy, vigorous, heavy bearing tree. Short storage life.

SWEET CHERRY PIE

Compact tree that makes it perfect for the home garden or small orchard. A sour pie cherry with the sweetest taste & fantastic for jams, jellies, & pies.

EVANS BALI

Deep, dark red fruit 1" in diameter, excellent for baking & fresh eating. The fruit is much sweeter than other sour cherries. Extremely hardy buds.

LAPIN CHERRY

A big, beautiful dark mahogany cherry that's one of the largest & juiciest cherries that grow on trees. The sweet taste is wonderful for baking & cooking. Highly resistant to browning.

Fruit is green-yellow, very juicy & approximately 2" in diameter. Has sturdy branching. Good for eating & canning. **Use 'Golden Spice' as pollinator.**

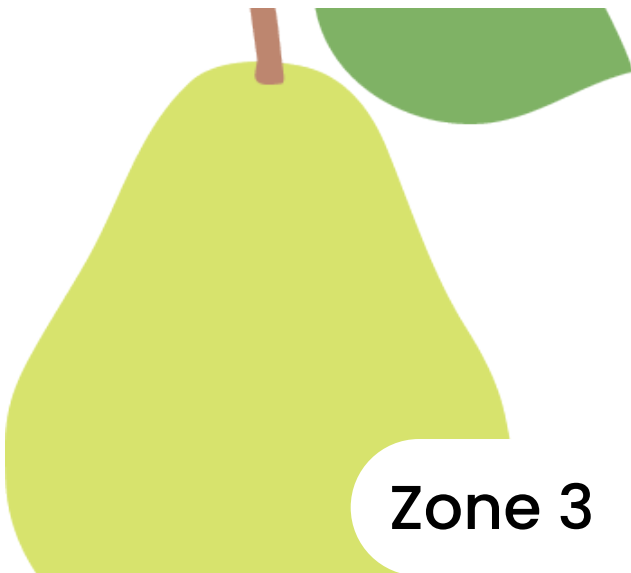

SUMMERCRISP

Free of fireblight. Annual bearer. Blooms early May. Use either 'Parker' or 'Patten' as pollinator.

TAWARA ASIAN

Tastes like a cross between apple & pear. Partially self-fruitful but yields better where two or more cultivars are planted.

GOLDEN SPICE

A very hardy pear. Ripens mid-season. Good for canning & spicing, fair for eating. Use 'Ure' as pollinator.

PARKER

Large, yellow-bronze fruit. Fine grained, tender & juicy. Upright & vigorous grower.



REDHAVEN

Flesh is firm, smooth textured & fine flavored. Fruit is medium size, round, uniform & appealing. Good for freezing, canning, & shipping. Disease resistant. One of the hardier peaches.

RELIANCE

Medium sized, roundish, yellow-fleshed peach that ripens with 'Redhaven'. Has a rather dull blush over green-yellow color. Flesh is bright yellow, rather soft & juicy. Flavor is fair. Good for fresh market in cold regions.

TIPS FOR GROWING

Most peaches are not the hardiest to this area but with TLC, the right spot, & some luck, you can be successful!

Good dessert plum. Yellow flesh, sweet & juicy. Large size, pointed fruit.

SUPERIOR
Large fruit with dark red skin. Good for fresh eating, jam & jelly. Flesh is yellow, sweet & juicy. Heavy bearing. Often sets fruit the first year. Use 'Toka' for pollination.

PURPLE PASSION

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 3-4' SPREAD: 2-3'

More tender, mild & sweet than standard varieties. Vigorous & productive, producing spears ready for harvesting a year earlier than most varieties.

JERSEY KNIGHT

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 3-4' SPREAD: 2-3'

A marked improvement over 'Mary Washington', with a much higher percent of male plants which produce larger spears.



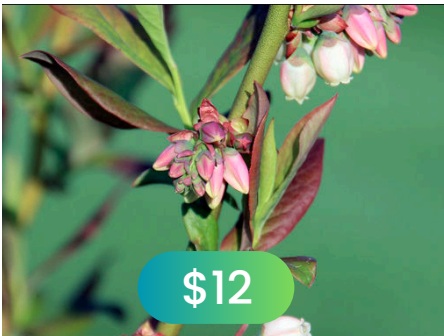

MARQUETTE GRAPE

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 3-4' SPREAD: 2-3'

A red wine variety that combines cold (to -36° F) & disease resistance w/ excellent wine quality. Tasters noted an attractive, deep red color, with desirable aromas of cherry, black pepper & spice.

PATRIOT BLUEBERRY

FULL SUN ZONE 3-8

HEIGHT: 4-6' SPREAD: 4-5'

Fruit is very large, firm & has small, dry recessed scars. Ripens early. Excellent flavor. Bush is upright, open & vigorous. Excellent landscape variety dark green foliage in the summer, & fiery orange fall colors.

BLUECROP

FULL SUN ZONE 4-7

HEIGHT: 4-6' SPREAD: 4-6'

A mid-season blueberry. Considered by many to be the best all around variety for consistent yields, disease resistance, & high quality. It has an upright, open growing habit. One of the best garden blueberry varieties on the market today.

BLUERAY

FULL SUN ZONE 4-7

HEIGHT: 5' SPREAD: 4'

Mid-season blueberry. A heavy producer of high quality large, powder-blue berries with outstanding dessert flavor. The beautiful rose-pink flowers turn bright white in full bloom. Foliage turns a burgundy color in the fall.

WENDY

FULL SUN ZONE 3-8

HEIGHT: 8-12" SPREAD: 12-16"

Wendy is a hardy, productive early June-bearing strawberry. Large, glossy red, wedge-shaped to conic berries are firm with bright red flesh & excellent flavor. Resistant to powdery mildew & red stele.

FT. LARAMIE

FULL SUN ZONE 3-10

HEIGHT: 4-10" SPREAD: 10-14"

Large scarlet-red berries with honey-sweet flavor. Firm texture is perfect eating fresh, freezing & preserves. Everbearing, producing berries from summer to fall.

HORSERADISH

FULL SUN ZONE 2-9

HEIGHT: 3-4' SPREAD: 3-4'

Horseradish is a beautiful perennial plant that is easy to grow & sends up long stems of white flowers in early to mid summer. The roots are generally dug in the fall, grated & mixed with vinegar. Jars will keep in the refrigerator for months.

REGENT SASKATOON SERVICEBERRY

HEIGHT: 4-6' SPREAD: 4-8'

A nicely shaped shrub form of juneberry. Large white flowers. The dark purple to black fruit is sweet & good for eating & making jelly. Xeriscape plant.



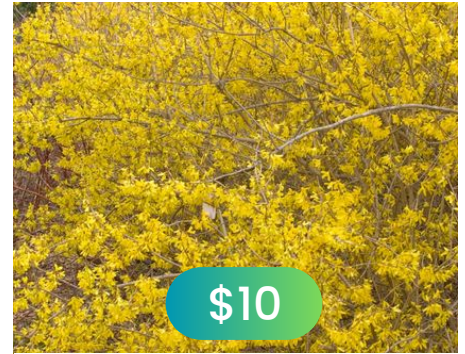

NISHIKI WILLOW

PART SUN ZONE 4-7

HEIGHT: 4-6' SPREAD: 4-6'

A lovely small shrub with pink stems & buds that open to dappled green, pink & white foliage. Some leaves will be all white. The stems are graceful & spreading. Best in partial shade.

MEADOWLARK FORSYTHIA

FULL SUN ZONE 3-8

HEIGHT: 8-10' SPREAD: 6-10'

A shrub with superior flower-bud hardiness & showy, bright yellow spring flowers, its flower buds are hardy to -35°F.



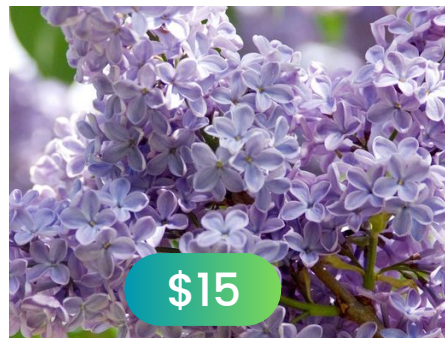

TINKERBELLE (PINK)

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 5-6' SPREAD: 4-5'

It exhibits a growth habit & bloom time similar to Dwarf Korean, but with a pleasing, spicy fragrance & incredible wine-red flower buds that open to pink.



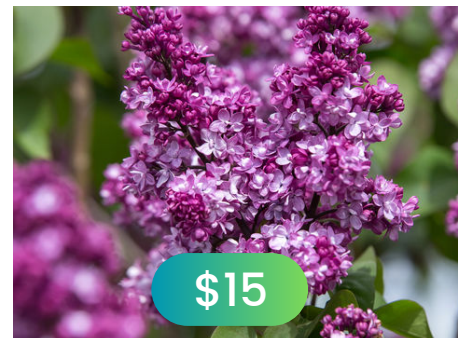

PRES LINCOLN (BLUE)

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 8-10' SPREAD: 10'

Possibly the truest blue of any lilac, this French hybrid bears thyrses of single, medium blue flowers. It's a good grower that produces basal shoots readily. Rarely to never fed on by Japanese beetles.



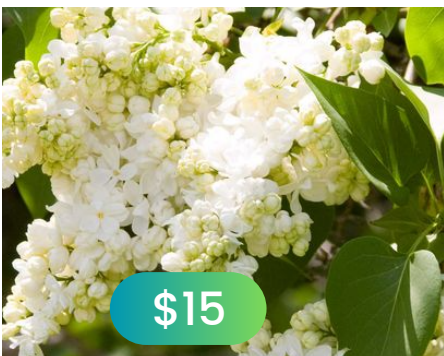

VIRTUAL VIOLET

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 6-8' SPREAD: 5-7'

Shiny violet new leaves, deep purple stems, raspberry-purple buds & fragrant violet flowers. The dense habit makes it a great choice for a hedge in smaller spaces as well as a welcome addition to foundation plantings. Remarkably mildew-free.

MME. LEMOINE (WHITE)

FULL SUN ZONE 3-7

HEIGHT: 8-10' SPREAD: 10'

This showy lilac bears panicles of double white flowers on a wide spreading bush. Rarely to never fed on by Japanese beetles.

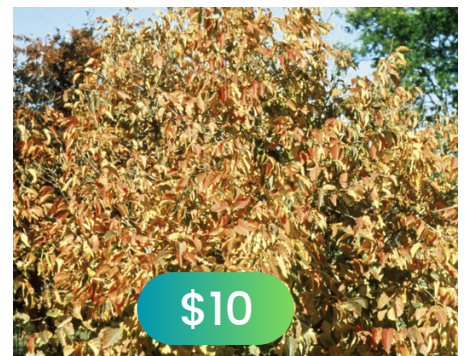

BEAUTY OF MOSCOW (PALE PINK)

HEIGHT: 10-12' SPREAD: 8'

This beautiful lilac produces abundant panicles of double, delicate pale pink flowers on a vigorous, upright plant. It is stunning in bloom. Rarely to never fed on by Japanese beetles.

AMERICAN HAZELNUT

FULL SUN/Partial Shade ZONE 4-9

HEIGHT: 6-8' SPREAD: 6-8'

Rounded edible nuts 1/2 inch wide & 2 to 4 in a cluster. Useful for the shrub border & in naturalistic settings. Sun or partial shade.

BULK COMPOST



Replacing up to 1/3 of the original soil with Leaf Compost or Garden Blend helps improve the growth of the new tree or shrub.

Compost is available in 1/2 cu. yd. increments, 1 cubic foot bags, or BYO 5gal bucket.
